



## CRANE EXAMINATION

### AIM

The course is specifically aimed at providing crane engineers with the information and techniques for thorough examination of most types of common crane. The course covers the following areas:

- Crawler Cranes

- Machinery House Equipment
- Booms/Winch drums/Wire ropes/Hook blocks
- Boom Trucks
- Barge/ship/offshore cranes
- Overhead Cranes

A short theory test will be taken and a practical examination to ensure safe practices are used is a major part of the course. A certificate of attendance will be issued which aids in addressing the various legislative requirements placed upon employers to ensure their employees are competent. The course includes a substantial handout for future reference.

### LOCATION
