



## LIFTING EQUIPMENT APPRECIATION

### AIM

To provide an introduction of lifting equipment, what it is and how it is used. The course briefly covers the requirements of the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER) and Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER).

With the wide range of lifting equipment used throughout industry our standard course introduces the following:

- Beam Trolleys
- Beam Clamps
- Shackles
- Wire Rope Slings
- Eyebolts
- Lifting and Pulling Machines
- Hand Operated Chain Blocks
- Round Slings
- Webbing Slings
- Chain Slings
- Plate Clamps
- Slewing Jib Cranes

The course is ideal as an introduction for procurement personnel who are responsible for purchasing lifting equipment, detailing some of the information that is required to be provided between the user and designer/supplier.

A short test will be taken and a certificate of attendance will be issued which aids in addressing the various legislative requirements placed upon employers.

### LOCATION

The course is generally held at our Head Office at Harworth, however we are able to utilise other Certex sites around the country and also hold courses at your site if adequate facilities are available.

### DURATION
