



LIFTING EQUIPMENT EXAMINATION

AIM

To provide an overview of the examination of in-service lifting equipment as required by the Statutory Instruction SI 2307.

The course reviews the requirements of the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER) and Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER). The course looks at the documentation required and various inspection techniques used.

With the wide range of lifting equipment used throughout industry it is impossible to cover everything, our standard course introduces the following:

- Runway Beams & Padeyes
- Beam Clamps
- Shackles
- Wire Rope Slings
- Eyebolts
- Lifting and Pulling Machines
- Jacks
- Lever Operated Chain Hoists
- Beam Trolleys
- Chain Blocks
- Webbing & Round Slings
- Chain Slings
- Plate Clamps
- Rigging Screws
- Swivel Hoist Rings
- Wedge and Socket

A practical and theory test will be taken and a certificate of attendance will be issued which aids in addressing the various legislative requirements placed upon employers.

There is a substantial course handout included in the package for delegates to refer to throughout the course and in the future.
