



SAFE USE AND PRE-USE INSPECTION

AIM

To give delegates detailed guidance on the safe use and pre-use of standard lifting equipment, detailed below. The course briefly covers the requirements of the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER) and Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998 (LOLER).

With the wide range of lifting equipment used throughout industry our standard course covers the safe use and pre use inspection of the following:

- Runway Beams & Pad Eyes
- Beam Clamps
- Shackles
- Wire Rope Slings
- Eyebolts
- Lifting and Pulling Machines
- Jacks
- Lever Operated Chain Hoists
- Beam Trolleys
- Chain Blocks
- Webbing & Round Slings
- Chain Slings
- Plate Clamps
- Rigging Screws
- Swivel Hoist Rings

It is possible to include other specific lifting equipment upon request

A short test will be taken a certificate of attendance will be issued which aids in addressing the various legislative requirements placed upon employers.

LOCATION

The course is generally held at our Head Office at Harworth, however we are able to utilise other Certex sites around the country and also hold courses at your site if adequate facilities are available.

DURATION
