



## SAFE SLINGING & LIFTING

### AIM

The course is specifically aimed at providing crane users with safe techniques for slinging and lifting operations. The course covers the following areas:

- Current Legislation
- Equipment Selection
- Banksman Duties and Signals
- Safe Use and Pre-use Inspection
- Sling angles
- Lifting Operation Planning
- Load Calculations
- Risk Assessments
- Sling Configurations
- Load Security

A short theory test will be taken and a practical examination to ensure safe practices are used is a major part of the course. A certificate of attendance will be issued which aids in addressing the various legislative requirements placed upon employers to ensure their employees are competent. The course includes a substantial handout for future reference and workbook examples which are completed during the course.

### LOCATION

The course is generally held at our Head Office at Harworth, however we are able to utilise other Certex sites around the country and also hold courses at your site if adequate facilities are available.

### DURATION
