



SOCKETING OF STEEL WIRE ROPES

AIM

To provide delegates with the most up to date knowledge on the resin socketing of steel wire ropes. The course involves an informative discussion on the techniques of socketing followed by a practical demonstration of how to socket standard six stranded and multi-stranded steel wire ropes.

The course covers the different types of rope construction, socket and rope terminations used, the properties of wirelock resin, the standard BS EN 13411-4:2002 and the method and step by step socketing procedure.

Each courses delegate will be expected to complete a written and practical examination which includes the proof loading of terminations
