- Working proactively with customers, employees, suppliers, contractors and interested parties to ensure that they do not operate to environmental standards that conflict with this policy statement.

- Seeking to conserve scarce and non-renewable resources, such as energy by using it efficiently to generate controllable emissions of the least harmful type.

- Using raw materials economically to create as little waste as possible and seeking to re-use, recycle and recover raw materials and waste wherever possible.
